Version 9.2 and later

Base Price Interoperability

Provides the possibility to mass upload new base price from JD Edwards interface table into the Item Base Price File table:

- Interface table F4106Z1 includes all 60-category codes from customer and item. Input Processor Batch Process R4106Z1 is used to extract the records from interface tables and insert/update the records to Item Base Price table F4106.
- Preference hierarchy number is used to process the records that belong to different hierarchy levels.(e.g. : item only/item and customer/ item group and customer.. etc.)
- Revision application P4106Z1 has been created where user can manually update/delete the records from interface table.
- Batch Process R4106Z1P purges the data from interface table after the records are successfully processed and added to F4106 table

Advanced Pricing Mass Maintenance

Advanced Pricing Mass Maintenance

The Mass Maintenance (**P45550**) application enables multiple price adjustment records to be maintained simultaneously, including updating or creating new records by copying existing ones.

The application can now be configured for Update or Copy mode, and the adjustment type can be specified (sales, procurement, or receipt).

In this session we will look at adjustment details relating to sales.

Advanced Pricing Mass Maintenance

The information displayed in the Mass Maintenance application is the records in F4072, Adjustment Details. You can use the QBE to do Ad Hoc filtering or create one or more Advanced Queries. There are also something called a Search Agent. This is functionality precedes the possibility to create Advanced Queries and does the same thing.

Advanced Pricing Mass Maintenance - Copy

Let's say we have some seasonal products where we would like to increase the prices during the summer months.

First, we use the Copy version to create a new date range for these seasonal items. We filter on the Adjustment Name and Date on the QBE line. *I appreciate that in this example there are very few records, but the same principle applies also for thousands of records.*

Advanced Pricing Mass Maintenance - Update

Remove your search criteria. Go to the field “Factor Numeric Value” and take the Visual Assist.

Define how the price should be updated. In this example we will do a percentage update and increase the prices with 10%. A minus sign will reduce the price accordingly.

The grid is updated and then saved in the same way as the copy action.

Advanced Pricing Mass Maintenance - Limitations

The Mass Maintenance application does not support copying or updating the following adjustment types:

- Sliding rate adjustments
- Enhanced basket reprice adjustments
- Inactive adjustments when Require Price Approval (Y/N) is checked on in Pricing Constants.
- Rounding rule adjustments
- Rebate adjustments

Mass Maintenance can only be used on records that already exists in F4072. It is not possible to upload new prices or adjustment via the Mass Maintenance application.



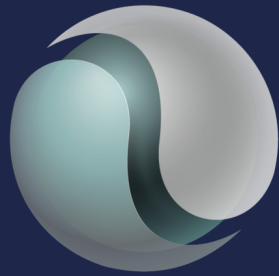
